

The One Minute Prayer

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What if the reason you keep borrowing money is not because you lack opportunity, but because you have not yet awakened the infinite supply within you. There is a divine law of provision written into the fabric of your Spiritual Self. It does not respond to fear. It does not respond to desperation. It responds to faith, clarity, and confident expectation. The moment you stop affirming lack and begin declaring abundance. The unseen force of life, the Holy Spirit begins rearranging circumstances in your favor.

The one minute prayer you are about to understand is not begging. It is not pleading. It is aligning. It is your cooperation with the infinite intelligence of the Holy Spirit and He knows how to meet your needs. You were not created to struggle. You were designed to prosper. Tonight you make a decision never to borrow again. Because His divine provision is now activated within you.

The Holy Ghost is the silent partner in all your financial experiences. He does not argue and He does not question the instructions you repeatedly give Him. He simply accepts, absorbs and acts upon the dominant thoughts impressed upon Him with feeling. Whether those thoughts are constructive or destructive. Abundant or fearful. He treats them as your desired command. Then if too wayward for your good benefit. He will strive to take you and your life into the very best Heaven inspired direction it ever can be towards your in Heaven made wish for desire you'd like to achieve inside this lifetime on Earth - your major definite purpose.

This is why your words and inner conversations about money are far more powerful than you realize. If you constantly say, "Money is hard to get. I'm always broke or I can't afford that." You

are merely describing your situation. You are instructing Him to reproduce that experience. The brain accepts repetition as your desired will for your life. Your brain does evaluate whether your statement is factual or emotional. It recognizes intensity and frequency. When lack filled statements are repeated with frustration or anxiety. They are impressed deeply and your brain rightly or wrongly works to make them real in your daily life.

Many people unknowingly hypnotize themselves into poverty by rehearsing limitation. They check their bank balance with fear. They speak about expenses with dread. They compare themselves with others and affirm their own insufficiency. Each of these acts plants seeds in the fertile soil of the infinite intelligence of the Holy Ghost. And like any soil, He does care what type of seed you plant. You will grow weeds just as faithfully as He grows flowers.

The truth is simple. What you repeatedly declare with emotion becomes your experience. Repetition creates belief. Belief shapes expectation. Expectation influences behavior. Behavior produces results. This entire chain begins in the brain. Consider how a child learns through repetition. If a child hears consistently you are smart and capable that message sinks deep and becomes a self concept. If the child hears you are not good enough that too becomes embedded. In the same way your brain has been programmed by years of repeated financial statements. Some spoken by you. Others spoken by authority figures in your life.

Perhaps you grew up hearing that money is scarce. That wealthy people are dishonest. Or that struggle is noble. Those repeated impressions may still be influencing your present financial condition. However, the beautiful truth is this. The Holy Ghost's infinite intelligence can be harnessed for your behalf, and this is powerful. He is divinely purposed. He is impressionable and He responds quickly to deliberate, emotionally charged affirmations of abundance. When you begin declaring, "Infinite supply flows to me." Now, you are planting a new seed. At first, your brain may say, "But that's not true." That resistance is simply the echo of older brain activity.

Persist gently. Continue affirming. Continue feeling the truth of abundance. The Holy Ghost does not respond to occasional statements. He responds to sustained conviction. Feeling is the secret ingredient. Words without emotion are like seeds without water. When you affirm abundance, feel relief, feel gratitude, feel certainty or imagine what it would feel like to always have more than enough. Let that feeling accompany your declaration. The Holy Ghost is also known as the Counsellor. He understands feeling as your chosen in the moment reality desire.

It is not necessary to know how the money will come. The Counsellor is connected to His infinite intelligence as Himself in everyone else not just you. He knows pathways you cannot see. Your task is not to force outcomes but to establish inner conviction. When He accepts the idea of supplying you with prosperity, that is as normal and natural as can be. He begins to influence your perceptions, ideas, and decisions.

You may suddenly notice opportunities you previously overlooked. You may feel inspired to take certain actions. You may meet people who assist your progress. What appears as coincidence is the inner work of the Counsellor on your behalf. Many individuals sabotage their own prosperity. Because their belief about money conflicts with their true desire for it. They say they want wealth. Yet deep inside they believe money brings stress, or that they are unworthy of abundance. The brain always wins this conflict. Unless you believe otherwise that the innermost promptings of the still small voice within of the Holy Ghost are ever working to improve your life.

Therefore, the work is not external struggle. It is internal agreement. When you repeatedly declare, "I always have more than enough." The Holy Ghost goes about establishing a new normal. He helps you begin to expect sufficiency instead of shortage. That expectation changes your posture toward

life. Instead of grasping. You become calm. Instead of fearing bills. You handle them with confidence. Instead of borrowing impulsively. You pause and trust that supply is unfolding.

Your brain thrives on consistency. Choose the one minute prayer and repeat it daily. Morning and night are especially powerful times. Because the brain is more relaxed, and the doorway to guidance from the Holy Ghost is open. Speak a prayer for His guidance softly, confidently and with gratitude. Do not strain. Do not force belief. Simply impress the idea of receiving His guidance gently and regularly.

Imagine Him as a vast ocean beneath the surface of your awareness. The thoughts you repeat are like currents directing the flow. If you constantly stir the waters with worry. The surface becomes turbulent. If you introduce calm certainty, the waters settle and clarity emerges. The habit of declaring lack may feel natural because it has been practiced for years. But habits are simply repeated patterns. Replace the old pattern with a new one. Every time you are tempted to say, "I can't afford it." Pause, replace it with, "I am open to divine provision." Each replacement weakens the brain's old imprint and strengthens the new neural activity.

Your financial life is not determined solely by external economy or circumstance. It is deeply influenced by your inner economy of thought. When your dominant inner conversation is abundance. Your outer world gradually reflects that conviction. The Holy Ghost is impartial towards your freedom of desire. He will allow you to think from a poverty consciousness or a prosperity consciousness with equal efficiency. Therefore guard your words well. Observe your thoughts. Choose declarations that agree with the life you desire rather than the life you fear.

As you persist, a shift occurs. You begin to feel secure even before evidence appears. That inner security is the first sign that the Holy Spirit has accepted your new declaration. From that point, change accelerates. Because your actions, decisions, and perceptions now harmonize with abundance rather than scarcity. You are not attempting to manipulate your reality. You are cooperating with Him. For you... sustained emotionally charged belief becomes experience. Impress abundance upon the Holy Ghost and your brain daily and the Counsellor within will faithfully reproduce abundance in forms that match your dominant declarations.

Fear is one of the most subtle and destructive forces operating within the human brain, especially in matters of money. Your brain announces itself loudly. It whispers doubts. Magnifies uncertainties and paints mental pictures of loss. When fear becomes the dominant emotion surrounding your finances. The brain impresses you with thoughts of insufficiency. The brain being obedient to your innermost belief. It will shape your experiences according to those fearful impressions. Borrowing money often begins long before the actual transaction. It begins in a mental state of panic. A bill arrives. An unexpected expense appears. Or income seems delayed. The brain reacts with anxiety. Thoughts race. What if I don't have enough? What if things get worse? What if I can't manage?

These thoughts repeated with emotional intensity are registered by the Counsellor as instructions to prepare for shortage. Fear contracts your awareness. When you are afraid. You cannot see clearly. Your thinking now becomes narrow and reactive. You focus only on the immediate problem. Not on the broader field of possibilities on offer through listening to the quiet still voice of the Counsellor within speaking His wise counsel to you.

Fear convinces you that supply is limited and time is running out. In that contracted state. Borrowing appears to be the only solution. It feels urgent, necessary, unavoidable. Yet fear does not originate from the external situation. It originates from interpretation. Two people may face the same financial challenge. One responds with calm confidence born from listening to the voice of the Counsellor within. The other with distress. The difference lies in their dominant belief about supply.

The one who trusts in divine infinite provision by way of the Counsellor experiences temporary difficulty without internal collapse. The one governed by fear experiences temporary difficulty as proof of permanent lack. The brain amplifies whatever emotion you dwell upon.

Fear when repeated becomes expectation. Expectation shapes perception. You notice evidence that supports your worry. Delays feel like confirmation. Minor setbacks appear catastrophic. Opportunities pass unseen. Because your brain is fixed on survival rather than on the Counsellor within you. Faith operates in the opposite manner. Faith is not blind optimism. It is a quiet inner assurance that there is a source greater than appearances. When you shift from fear to faith. You expand your mental horizon.

You no longer see yourself as dependent solely on visible resources. This is when the brain, the Counsellor and your Spiritual Self identity come into disagreement due to the fear activities of the brain. It ever working against your faithful spiritual nature which is in a rivalry with the brain's activities. Your Spiritual Identity remaining outside the brain as it exists as an energy field surrounding your physical body and it is your immortal True Self, whose true and greatest joy is in your best home in Heaven.

You recognize that your intelligence, creativity, connections, and ideas are channels through which the Counsellor's divine supply flows. Faith releases tension from the body and gives clarity by producing new neural activity inside the brain. When you are calm. Your thinking becomes resourceful. You consider alternatives. You negotiate wisely. You manage expenses with discernment rather than panic. Faith does not deny facts. With faith in the Counsellor you refuse to be dominated by them.

Many individuals unknowingly worship their pay check as their source. When the pay check seems insufficient. Fear arises. Because the perceived source appears threatened. But the pay check is only a channel. A channel can change. Your divine source remains, when you understand that infinite intelligence from the Holy Ghost is your true source. Your emotional dependence shifts from outer forms to inner certainty. Fear says there is not enough. Faith in Him says there is always a way. Fear anticipates loss. Faith anticipates provision. The Counsellor being receptive responds to whichever voice you amplify.

When you dwell in fear. Your body chemistry changes. Stress hormones increase. Your decisions become hurried. You may overspend impulsively out of anxiety. Or make commitments you later regret. Fear driven actions often creates the very financial strain you wish to avoid. The cycle continues because the results of fear reinforce more fear. Breaking this cycle requires deliberate inner work. You must interrupt the fearful thought the moment it appears. Do not fight it violently. Simply replace it. When the thought arises, I won't have enough. Gently affirm the Counsellor with me is my constant and reliable divine supply.

When the brain imagines worst case scenarios. Consciously strive to hear the Counsellor and embrace His favorable outcomes. This is not denial. It is redirection. Your brain does not distinguish between imagined danger and real danger. If you repeatedly visualize financial disaster. Your brain reacts as if it is happening now. That chronic stress clouds judgement and weakens confidence. Conversely, when you visualize a successful resolution. Your body relaxes and your brain activity adapts to your faith. This counter activity is cultivated through repetition just as fear is.

If you have rehearsed worry for years. It may feel natural. But you can rehearse trust in His ever present guidance with equal persistence. Each time you choose a faith filled thought. You weaken the old neural pathway of anxiety and strengthen a new pathway of confidence. Trusting that the

divine intelligence of the Holy Spirit will ever govern your life, and this does not mean you become passive. It means you act from steadiness rather than desperation.

When you are not gripped by fear. The Holy Ghost divinely guides you to handle money with dignity. You plan wisely, you save consistently, you invest thoughtfully, you communicate confidently. Your external actions reflect internal assurance from the Counsellor ever within you.

Borrowing driven by fear often carries hidden emotional cost, shame, pressure, resentment. Faith driven decisions, even when they involve temporary assistance. Are made without inner turmoil. Because they arise from clarity rather than panic. The difference is subtle. But powerful. When you affirm - the source of my supply is His infinite and unfailing guidance. You are shifting your loyalty from appearances to principle.

His divine infinite intelligence has countless ways of expressing provision. An idea may come that increases your income. A new opportunity may emerge unexpectedly. A solution you had not considered may present itself naturally. Fear limits possibilities to what you currently see. Faith recognizes possibilities beyond present sight. Fear is reactive. Faith is creative. Fear shrinks. Faith expands. Fear closes doors in the imagination.

Faith in Him opens corridors you did not know existed. As you practice choosing faith. You will notice a change in your inner dialogue. The urgent tone softens. The catastrophic thinking fades. Even when challenges arise, your first response becomes calm inquiry rather than alarm. That shift alone alters the trajectory of your financial life. The brain thrives on dominant emotion. If fear has dominated. Your results will mirror it. If faith becomes dominant. Your results will gradually reflect confidence and provision. The transition may not be instantaneous, but it is inevitable when sustained.

You are not required to eliminate all doubt at once. You are invited to reduce its influence daily. Each moment you choose trust in Him over worry. You impress a new belief pattern upon the brain. Each affirmation of supply weakens the habit of fear. Faith is not a dramatic display. It is a steady conviction maintained quietly within. It is the decision to believe in the unseen support of the Holy Ghost. Even when visible resources fluctuate. It is the calm refusal to panic. It is the inner declaration that your life is guided, sustained, and supplied by Him beyond present evidence.

The one minute prayer is not a ritual of pleading. It is a deliberate act of agreement in divine provision ever being supplied on your behalf for your growing prosperity. It is a conscious decision to synchronize your thoughts, emotions and expectations with His divine order.

In a single focused minute. You can redirect the momentum of your brain from confusion to clarity. From scarcity to supply. The power of prayer does not lie in its length. But in its intensity and consistency. Many people believe long prayers are more powerful. Yet, the Holy Ghost responds not to duration. But to conviction. A single minute of concentrated faith is more effective than an hour of distracted repetition. When you speak words of faith with calm authority. You are impressing yourself with His divinely given blueprint of order and abundance.

The purpose of the one minute prayer is to establish harmony between your persistent desire and your belief. If you desire prosperity but the brain thinks lack. There is inner conflict. This prayer dissolves this inner conflict by reaffirming truth in a clear emotionally charged manner. When you say, "**Divine wisdom guides my finances.**" You are acknowledging that the Counsellor's divine infinite intelligence that is greater than your limited reasoning is directing your decisions. Guidance is essential in financial matters. Many mistakes arise from impulsive action, emotional spending, or fear based choices. When you affirm divine wisdom. You are conditioning yourself to seek His

insight before action. You begin to feel His intuitive nudges, moments of pause, and ideas for improvement. His subtle impressions about what to pursue or avoid. These impressions are often gentle, but they become clearer as you practice this prayer daily.

The next declaration... **“Divine order governs my expenses.”** Introduces harmony into what may have felt chaotic. Disorder in finances often reflects disorder held in the brain. When bills appear overwhelming. It is easy to feel scattered and pressured. By affirming your faith in His divine order. You are instructing Him to organize your financial life. You begin to action spending more clearly, you action to become more intentional, you notice patterns that previously escaped your awareness. Order does not mean restriction. It means intelligent arrangement. When your expenses are governed by His wisdom rather than impulse. Money flows more efficiently. Waste diminishes naturally. Because you yourself now associate spending with purpose rather than emotion. You feel calm when reviewing your finances. Because you have impressed the idea that everything is unfolding under the Counsellor's guidance.

When you declare, **“Divine abundance multiplies my income.”** You are expanding your mental concept of His constantly ever unfolding, new ideas, and new projects for your new supply of income. Many individuals unconsciously limit their income by believing it can only come from one source. This belief narrows your chosen innermost desire, and your listening to the voice of the Counsellor, and and this brain activity restricts opportunity. By affirming multiplication. You open yourself to His creative possibilities, ideas for additional income, new ventures, partnerships, or improvements may arise effortlessly.

Multiplication begins in belief before it appears in faith in Him. You must first accept increase as natural. If you embrace and empower the belief that earning more is difficult or reserved for others that acts as a ceiling. The one minute prayer gently lifts that ceiling by replacing limitation with agreed in expansion through the workshop of the Holy Ghost. The word multiplies carries energy of growth and increase. Planting the expectation of more rather than barely enough.

Consistency is the secret to practice. Repeating the prayer three times a day, morning, midday, and night, creates rhythmic reinforcement. In the morning, you set the tone for the day. Midday you recalibrate if fear has attempted to intrude. At night you say the prayer just before sleep. When you yourself are most receptive. These moments act like anchors. Stabilizing your financial outlook. The manner in which you speak the prayer matters deeply. Speak slowly. Allowing each phrase to sink beneath the surface of your awareness. Feel the meaning of the words. You end the prayer when you say, **“I am supported, and sustained at all times.”**

Pause and imagine what support feels like. Imagine stability beneath your actions. Imagine His invisible hands and infinite intelligence arranging circumstances in your favor. Emotion transforms your prayer words into living forces. Without feeling. The prayer remains intellectual. With feeling it becomes creative. The Holy Ghost responds to your emotional desire. When you combine repetition with gratitude and certainty, you accelerate acceptance.

Do not rush the minute. 60 seconds of focused faith can recalibrate an entire day. In that minute, you withdraw attention from external appearances and place it upon Him and He is God. You refuse to let temporary conditions dictate permanent belief. You choose instead to declare what you desire to see manifested. It is also important to release strain. The one minute prayer is not a desperate attempt to force results. Strain signals doubt. Calm conviction gifts faith. After you complete the prayer, let it go.

Trust that the seed has been planted. Go about your activities with quiet assurance. He will continue working on your behalf, even when your brain shifts to other tasks. Over time you may notice

subtle changes. You feel less anxious when thinking about money. You respond more thoughtfully to financial decisions. Opportunities appear that validate your faith. Even challenges seem less threatening. Because of His work... your inner foundation has strengthened. Repetition helps create a new belief. Belief shapes identity.

When you consistently declare that His divine wisdom guides your finances. You begin to see yourself as guided. When you affirm that abundance multiplies your income. You begin to expect growth. Expectation alters perception. You notice possibilities others overlook because you look for expansion rather than restriction. The one minute prayer is simple. But simplicity does not diminish its power. It is like a tuning fork that brings your inner world into harmony with His guidance.

When your thoughts, emotions and words vibrate in agreement with abundance. You become receptive to His divine guided steps given in your favor. Even if doubt arises, continue. Doubt is merely residue of previous brain activity. Persistent faith gradually dissolves any old patterns. Each repetition strengthens new neural pathways associated with trust, clarity, and prosperity. As you practice daily. The prayer becomes less of an exercise and more of a state of being. You carry the awareness of guidance throughout your day.

You handle conversations about money with confidence. You make plans with expectation of success. You rest at night with assurance that supply is active beyond your immediate awareness. The one minute prayer is not about changing the outer world directly. It is about transforming the inner atmosphere from which the outer world emerges. When the inner atmosphere is saturated with His order, wisdom, and abundance. The outer experience reorganizes in response to that dominant impression. Imagination is the most underused financial asset you possess. It is the silent architect of your circumstances, the inner workshop where His blueprints of your future are drafted, long before they appear in physical form.

Every thing imaginable first existed as an idea, every invention began as a mental image. In the same way. Your debt free and prosperous life must first be clearly constructed in Him before it can be expressed in experience. You can communicate to Him through images and feelings more readily than through logic. When you form a vivid mental picture of yourself being financially free. You are giving the brain a pattern to reproduce with the help of the still small voice of the Holy Ghost. If you constantly imagine unpaid bills. Embarrassment or struggle. Those images become templates. However the Holy Spirit tirelessly works to bring your outer life into harmony with your dominant inner pictures.

To reverse financial limitation. You must replace fear of lack with faith in financial freedom. Close your eyes and see yourself reviewing your finances with calm confidence. Picture your debts marked paid in full. See your banking reflecting steady growth. Imagine receiving income with gratitude and being empowered by His infinite wisdom. Allow the scene to feel natural, not exaggerated. The more ordinary and believable the image becomes. The more easily the brain accepts it.

Many people attempt visualization but abandon it because they do not see immediate results. They forget that repetition impresses images deeply. A single mental rehearsal may create a powerful imprint. The brain thrives on this consistency. When you return to the same prosperous image again and again, the brain begins to treat that image as a familiar reality. The key is emotional involvement. If you visualize abundance but feel anxiety beneath the surface. The anxiety becomes the stronger imprint.

Therefore, when you imagine your debt free life. Also imagine the relief that accompanies it. Feel the lightness in your chest, feel the calm in your mind, feel the gratitude rising within you. Feeling

energizes the image and signals to the brain that this picture is significant. Imagination is not escapism. It is preparation. You mentally rehearse financial freedom before it materializes. You are training your brain to recognize prosperity as normal. When you repeatedly see yourself prosperous, your identity begins to shift. You no longer see yourself as someone trying to escape debt. You see yourself as someone who manages abundance wisely. Identity influences behavior. A person who identifies as responsible naturally acts responsibly. A person who identifies as prosperous naturally makes decisions aligned with growth rather than desperation.

Visualization also reduces fear in the brain. When you picture a favorable outcome frequently. It feels less distant and more attainable. The unknown becomes familiar. Instead of the brain imagining worst case scenarios. You rehearse your desired best case reality. This shift changes your emotional baseline from anxiety to expectation. It is important to visualize specific scenes rather than vague concepts. Instead of thinking, "I am rich." Imagine a concrete moment, sitting at your desk reviewing positive financial statements. Making a generous donation without hesitation, investing confidently, or planning a vacation without worry.

Specific images are easier for the brain to translate into experience. Because they provide detail and context. Your brain cannot distinguish between a vividly imagined event and a physically experienced one. When you imagine with clarity and emotion. Your brain responds as if it is real. Confidence increases. Stress diminishes. Your body relaxes. In that relaxed state. Creative solutions surface more easily from the Holy Ghost.

Visualization should be practiced in a state of calm. Early morning or just before sleep are ideal moments. Because the brain is less critical of you. As you drift into relaxation, gently introduce the image of your prosperous Spiritual Self. Do not strain. Allow the scene to unfold naturally. If distractions arise, return to the image without frustration. Consistency builds momentum. Each day you reinforce the image of financial freedom, you weaken the brain's thoughts of limitation. Over time, the prosperous picture feels more authentic than the brain's memory of struggle.

When this shift occurs, outer change accelerates. Because your brain is now agreeing with your faith led abundance, and in turn guides your belief driven perceptions. When your inner image is one of abundance. You begin noticing opportunities given by the Holy Ghost. You may perceive His new ideas for income, creative solutions to reduce expenses, or connections that support growth. These opportunities may have existed before, but your brain's perceived lack prevented you from seeing them clearly.

Seeing yourself debt free, changes how you handle obligations. Instead of reacting with dread, you respond with His divine strategy. Instead of avoiding financial review. You approach it with clarity. Your images of freedom become a compass guiding daily decisions. It is essential to avoid conflicting images. If you spend 5 minutes visualizing prosperity, but hours of the brain worrying about scarcity. The dominant impression remains lack. Guard your spiritual nature throughout the day. When negative pictures arise, gently replace them with your chosen image of success. This discipline trains the brain to favor positive constructive patterns.

Gratitude enhances visualization. As you imagine your prosperous future, feel grateful as though it has already unfolded. Gratitude signals completion of a desire. When you combine visualization with gratitude. You move from hoping to knowing. The human brain responds more quickly to images that carry the emotional tone of fulfillment. Your imagination is a gift designed to collaborate with the divine intelligence of the Holy Ghost. He's the channel through, which your abundance turns into an infinite potential that takes form in your personal experience. By directing your imagination toward debt freedom and prosperity. You are participating in creation rather than reacting to circumstances. Over time, the boundary between imagination and reality begins to blur.

The confidence you feel during visualization carries into daily life. Your speech reflects His calm certainty, your posture reflects His assurance, your decisions reflect His wisdom. Others sense this change and respond accordingly. He is opening doors that validate your inner expectations. His divine workshop within you is always active. If you do not consciously build images of abundance. The brain will replay thoughts of limitation gathered from past experiences. Take ownership of the divine workshop of the Holy Ghost.

Design carefully, rehearse faithfully, feel deeply. His divine counsel you hold consistently becomes the brain pattern your life follows. Now, gratitude is one of the most transformative forces you can cultivate in your financial life. It shifts your focus from what is missing to what is present. It redirects your attention from lack to supply. The Holy Ghost responds powerfully to gratitude. Because gratitude implies possession. When you are grateful, you are affirming that something good from Him already exists in your experience. Your gratitude also impresses the brain with the idea of sufficiency rather than scarcity.

Many people believe they will feel grateful once they have more money. Yet the Holy Ghost works with your faith in His guidance. Think, you'll receive more when you feel grateful now. Gratitude is not a reaction to abundance. It is an effect of abundance. When you appreciate what you currently have. You create an inner atmosphere of completeness.

The Holy Ghost accepts that atmosphere as your normal state and seeks to maintain and expand it. If you constantly focus on unpaid bills, limited income, or delayed opportunities. You reinforce the brain's ideas of not enough. The brain does not respond to what you wish were true. It reproduces situations that mirror dissatisfaction. When appreciation dominates, it multiplies experiences of perception; being what you see and what you do not see that justify appreciation.

Through inner work on your behalf by the Holy Ghost, your gratitude changes your emotional frequency, instead of tension, there is calm, instead of envy, there is contentment, instead of comparison, there is confidence. These emotional shifts influence your decisions. Through His influence a grateful person manages money differently from a resentful one. Gratitude encourages stewardship. He will in turn inspire care, attention, and respect for resources. Even if your current finances seem modest, there is always something to appreciate. You can be thankful for the income you do receive, for the skills you possess, for the opportunities available to you, for the lessons learned from past challenges.

Each moment of sincere appreciation plants a seed in the brain where the Holy Ghost picks it up and guides you towards the realization of your written on paper goals. Those seeds grow quietly beneath the surface. When you say, "I am deeply grateful for the abundance already present in my life." You are training your brain to search for evidence of abundance. With the help of the Holy Ghost the brain tends to find what it looks for. If you search for lack, you will notice limitations, if you search for supply, you will notice provision. He sharpens your awareness of blessings that previously seemed ordinary before gratitude.

Borrowing often arises from a mentality of insufficiency. When you feel that what you have is never enough, urgency takes control. Gratitude dissolves that urgency by helping you to affirm that there is already support from the Holy Ghost empowering you. This does not mean you deny growth. It means you grow from a foundation of appreciation rather than desperation. The brain interprets gratitude as completion, and that's a very good thing. So you can now move onwards and upwards to something else, some new idea or project from the Counsellor to bring you to abundance on your behalf.

When you feel thankful. You are mentally declaring this is good, this is sufficient. The brain's

seeking for consistency brings additional experiences that match that declaration. The Holy Ghost expands the condition you appreciate. Because He recognizes that you are identifying keenly with abundance.

Gratitude also reduces fear. Fear focuses on future lack. Gratitude anchors you in His present provision. When you acknowledge what is working in your life. Anxiety loses intensity. You feel His support rather than feeling threatened. His support strengthens your confidence in handling financial matters wisely. Practicing gratitude intentionally each day conditions your brain for prosperity activity in the form of perceptions given to promote new opportunities revealed and capitalized upon by the divinely led role of the Holy Ghost.

Begin in the morning by acknowledging three financial blessings, no matter how small. Perhaps you have paid a bill on time, received helpful advice, or discovered a new opportunity. Speak your appreciation silently or aloud. Feel the sincerity of it. During the day, if you make a purchase, silently give thanks for the ability to do so. This transforms spending from a painful loss into a joyful exchange. You recognize that money is flowing, not disappearing. Circulation replaces contraction in your life experience. In the evening review the day and identify moments of provision.

Through the power and influence of the Holy Ghost; maybe you avoided an unnecessary expense, found a discount, received unexpected assistance, or gained clarity about your goals. Each acknowledgement by you, strengthens the impression of abundance in your mind. Through Him - gratitude also affects how others perceive you, your brain will radiate positivity. People are naturally drawn to individuals who appreciate rather than complain. Opportunities often arise through relationships. And gratitude enhances those relationships, creating goodwill, trust, and collaboration.

When you appreciate the money you have, you treat it with respect. You budget thoughtfully. You avoid careless spending. You plan with intention. Respect invites increase. Because you demonstrate readiness to handle more. The Holy Ghost interprets careful stewardship as competence and through it He inspires new growth. It is important to avoid mechanical gratitude. Simply repeating words without feeling will have little effect. Pause long enough to experience genuine appreciation.

Reflect on how your life would feel without the blessings you currently enjoy. Contrast strengthens appreciation. From that awareness, gratitude becomes authentic. Gratitude does not ignore your desire to achieve. You can desire greater prosperity while appreciating your ability to change your present condition. In fact, desires rooted in gratitude are healthier than desires rooted in frustration. When you strive from appreciation. Your efforts feel inspired rather than pressured.

The practice of gratitude gradually transforms your financial identity. You stop identifying as someone struggling to get by and begin identifying as someone already blessed and expanding. Identity shapes expectation, expectation influences outcome. Over time, gratitude becomes habitual. You insightfully look for good in every financial situation. Even challenges are framed as lessons or redirections. This perspective prevents discouragement from taking root in the brain. The more consistently you cultivate appreciation, the more natural abundance feels.

You begin to expect favorable outcomes. Because you are accustomed to recognizing them. That expectation influences your tone of voice, your posture, your negotiations, and your planning. Gratitude is the multiplier because you confirm value. When you value what you have. He helps you attract more value. When you cherish small increases, you prepare for larger ones. Appreciation signals readiness. As this attitude of readiness to achieve more deepens. Borrowing loses its

emotional pull. You no longer operate from panic or perceived emptiness. You operate from recognition of His continuous divinely given support.

You trust that His provision is ever unfolding. That His supply is ever active and growing. And that this growth through Him is natural. And that your life is already enriched in countless visible and invisible ways through His efforts on your behalf. You are not dependent on external circumstances. You are in agreement with His infinite reservoir of wisdom, health, success, and abundance. From this moment forward, you believe in your God given right to abundance, you speak abundance, you expect abundance. The one minute prayer is your daily agreement with divine provision. Practice it faithfully, feel it deeply. Trust it completely and watch as through Him - doors open, ideas come, opportunities appear, resources flow naturally, steadily, and generously. You were never meant to live in lack. You were ment to live supplied.

The entire one minute prayer follows: **“Divine wisdom guides my finances, divine order governs my expenses, divine abundance multiplies my income, I am supported and sustained at all times.” - Amen.**
